


This game can be played on any device that has Microsoft PowerPoint, including PC computers, MacBooks, tablets and iPads.


This game works best in small groups or one-on-one practice with the teacher.



A Click and Go is a game where questions are answered. There's no scoreboard. Just questions and answers.


Simple directions allow anyone, student, teacher, or even a substitute, to operate.






There are 40 questions per game, more than enough for each student to answer a question.






Students a given a question to answer. There's one question per slide.

Click on the "Answer Button" to reveal the correct answer.







Click "Back" to go to the previous question. Click "Next" to the go to the next question. Click the "Stop" button to quit.


*Mac products do not allow type in scoreboard. Mac/iPad versions must use buttons instead.




Here are some of questions from this game. Answers are covered so students won't see them until you click the "Answer" button.










